



## Gingerbread House Contest 2019

### Rules

1. There is no cost to enter.
2. Enter each entry in one of the four following categories:
  - Category 1:** Original Home Crafted Design (Children, 18 years old and under)
  - Category 2:** Original Home Crafted Design (Adults over 18 years old)
  - Category 3:** Decorate a gingerbread house from a kit (Children, 18 years old and under)
  - Category 4:** Decorate a gingerbread house from a kit (Adults over **18 years old**)
3. Include your name, age, phone number and category on each entry.
4. The entire display, except for the base, shall be made of edible materials. Entries may use lollipops, unwrapped candy, cookies, crackers, cereals, pasta and any other food items. Gingerbread "houses" can also be barns, birdhouses, lighthouses, airplanes or any other imaginative dwellings.
5. Construction may include pre-baked items such as graham crackers and cookies. For best construction, use Royal Icing only (no butter-cream).
6. All entries shall be on a wooden or heavy cardboard base, no larger than 18" x 18". Please give your house a special "Holiday Name"
7. Bring your entry to the Golden Windmill Hall on Friday, December 6 between 3 PM and 8 PM or on Saturday, December 7 before 10 AM.
8. All entries will be available for pickup on December 7 after 2 PM. Entries not picked up by 3 PM will be discarded.
9. Entries are judged on overall appearance (30 pts), originality/creativity (30 pts), workmanship/technique (30 pts), and difficulty (10 pts). Visitors may vote for a "People's Choice" award.
10. Prizes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place in each category.
11. The Golden Historical Society reserves the right to use their name in a newsletter or website for promotional purposes.
